Excursion Bag Check List - Caribbean

To help everyone prepare for your excursions, here are some suggestions on what you should consider when packing to leave the ship for a day's excursion. Keep in mind that although the Caribbean is a more "relaxed" destination, your own taste, interests, and activities will determine what you bring. The daily weather will vary from cool and cold mornings to warm days and back to cool afternoons and evenings.

And if you are flying or going to higher altitudes you will need warm clothing. Comfortable apparel and good walking or hiking shoes are important for sightseeing. Depending on your personal needs, you can travel as light as you wish. It can be a fanny pack, tote bag or back-pack for shore excursions/carry-on for overnight if on a cruise tour. However, if you are taking extra items, cameras, jackets, etc. one nap-sack or backpack should be fine for a couple. Star packing a week early, so you will not forget something.

Check these items off or circle them as you pack.
